LURIANIC KABBALAH INTRODUCED CONCEPTS SUCH AS TZIMTZUM (DIVINE CONTRACTION), SHEVIRAT HA-KELIM (SHATTERING OF THE VESSELS), AND TIKKUN OLAM (REPAIR OF THE WORLD), WHICH HAVE PROFOUNDLY INFLUENCED SUBSEQUENT KABBALISTIC THOUGHT AND PRACTICE. - BINAH (UNDERSTANDING): THE PROCESS OF CONCEPTUALIZATION AND FORMATION.

- CHESED (KINDNESS/LOVE): UNCONDITIONAL GIVING AND EXPANSION.
- GEVURAH (STRENGTH/JUDGMENT): RESTRAINT, DISCIPLINE, AND CONTRACTION.
- TIFERET (BEAUTY/HARMONY): BALANCE, COMPASSION, AND INTEGRATION.
- NETZACH (ETERNITY/ENDURANCE): VICTORY, PERSEVERANCE, AND WILL.
- HOD (SPLENDOR/GLORY): HUMILITY, SURRENDER, AND EXPRESSION.
- YESOD (FOUNDATION): THE CONDUIT, THE CHANNEL OF DIVINE FLOW.
- MALKHUT (KINGDOM): MANIFESTATION, RECEPTION, AND PHYSICAL REALITY.

The capitalisation employed in these pages may also appear unusual, but it is the one traditionally used among students of the Western Esoteric Tradition. In this system, common words, such as earth or path, are used in a technical sense to denote spiritual principles. When this is done, a capital is used to indicate the fact. When a capital is not used, it may be taken that the word is to be understood in its ordinary sense. As I have frequently referred to the authority of MacGregor Mathers and Aleister Crowley in matters of Qabalistic mysticism, it may be as well to explain my position in relation to these two writers. I was at one time a member of the organisation founded by the former, but have never been associated with the latter. I have never known either of these gentlemen personally, MacGregor Mathers having died before I joined his organisation, and Aleister Crowley having then ceased to be associated with it.
