Itu tentunya menjadi salah satu hal yang membuat orang-orang ogah jadi penulis buku, terlebih dalam bidang-bidang yang memerlukan tak hanya tenaga dan pikiran, tetapi juga “ongkos” untuk mengerjakannya, semisal buku penelitian sosial. Kampus, yang seharusnya jadi tempat utama berkembangnya pemikiran intelektual, justru tak akrab dengan buku. Kegiatan perbukuan belum dilirik secara maksimal oleh pihak universitas di Indonesia. Sebagai acuan “keintelektualan” kampus, universitas masih mengedepankan jurnal dan artikel belaka. Ini sangat disayangkan, sebab seperti yang dikatakan Buldan-pegiat literasi dari penerbitan Bentang Pustaka, “gengsi intelektual/akademik perguruan tinggi ada di penerbitannya.” Atau, dengan kata lain, penilaian terhadap kondisi akademik yang baik pada suatu universitas terletak pada seberapa besar “interaksi” mahasiswa dan dosen dengan buku, dalam kegiatan membaca dan menulis. Adhe dalam bukunya Declare! Kamar Kerja Penerbit Jogja (1998-2007) juga mengatakan, “di universitas kita (Indonesia) membuat buku belum menjadi sebuah kebanggaan sebagaimana tradisi di luar negeri.”

Kalau sudah begini, implikasinya berarti mahasiswa banyak yang tidak terbiasa dengan buku. Kita pasti sudah tahu bahwa kegiatan literasi-menulis dan membaca-di lingkungan universitas memang belum baik adanya. Jika “sarang intelektual” saja masih begitu asing dengan buku, tentu bisa kita bayangkan seberapa minimnya interaksi yang dilakukan masyarakat non akademisi dengan buku. Beritaberita mengenai rendahnya tingkat literasi masyarakat Indonesia menjadi semacam bukti akan kenyataan tersebut. Keadaan ini tentu cukup memprihatinkan. Namun, dalam lingkungan perbukuan yang seperti itu, masih ada orang-orang yang membaktikan hidupnya dalam kerja perbukuan dan dunia literasi. Mereka, nampaknya, adalah apa yang Adhe sebut dalam bukunya sebagai “pendekar”. Orang-orang yang memilih berkegiatan bersama buku dibanding merintis hidup di jalur finansial yang nyaman dan aman. Kisah mereka ini ditulis dan dibukukan oleh para anggota Lembaga Kajian Mahasiswa Universitas Negeri Jakarta. Dalam tulisan berjudul “Dua Sisi Koin Kepeng”, kita bersua dengan Azmi Abubakar. Seorang keturunan Aceh yang setia mengumpulkan segala macam kepustakaan orang-orang Tionghoa Indonesia, sekaligus pendiri Museum Pustaka Peranakan Tionghoa. Baktinya pada buku ia tujukan untuk suatu tujuan mulia, yaitu menghapus diskriminasi terhadap orang Tionghoa di Indonesia. Ia merasa sedih dengan peristiwa kekerasan yang terjadi di bulan Mei tahun 1998 dan banyak diarahkan pada masyarakat Tionghoa. Dari kesimpulannya, yang menyebabkan hal semacam itu terjadi adalah sedikitnya informasi yang diterima masyarakat mengenai etnis Tionghoa Indonesia, dari sumbangsihnya pada negara maupun mengenai budaya mereka, yang secara sengaja memang dilenyapkan oleh Orde Baru sewaktu berkuasa. Untuk alasan itulah ia mengumpulkan begitu banyak kepustakaan Tionghoa Indonesia, supaya masyarakat bisa mengenal lebih dekat siapa dan bagaimana etnis Tionghoa Indonesia selama ini. Baginya sendiri, usaha mengumpulkan kepustakaan Tionghoa dirasakan sangat penting. “Ini adalah identitas bangsa Indonesia. Kalau ini memasuki ruangruang pengetahuan anak bangsa, di situ kita bisa tinggal landas (maju). Kita ini masalah konsolidasi kebangsaan sesama kita, sesama etnis, selesai dulu menurut saya.” Kata Azmi yang hendak membangun suasana di mana tidak ada perbedaan, semua setara di antara sesamanya. Sementara itu, Aufa Hanifah melirik pegiat literasi yang berbeda latar belakang. Ia berjumpa dengan Oyon Sofyan, mantan ketua Pusat Dokumentasi Sastra HB Jassin yang dekat dengan Sang Paus Sastra secara pribadi. Ia bahkan tahu betul apa yang diinginkan Sang Paus Sastra dengan Pusat Dokumentasi Sastranya. Aufa menuliskannya dalam tulisannya yang berjudul “Sebuah Kerja yang Dituliri Sang Paus”: “Ujarnya (Pak Oyon) dengan intonasi yang sangat tenang, ia mengatakan keinginan Jassin tentang PDS ke depan yang bertingkat-tingkat. Tingkat satu sastra daerah, tingkat dua sastra Indonesia, tingkat tiga sastra dunia.” Dengan keadaan itu, Jassin berharap orang Indonesia yang hendak belajar sastra dunia tak perlu ke luar negeri lagi. Begitu pula dengan sastra daerah yang mudah diakses. Meski begitu, kenyataannya PDS HB Jassin masih jauh sekali dengan apa yang Sang Paus Sastra sendiri inginkan. Aufa melihat kenyataan tersebut ketika berkunjung ke PDS HB Jassin: “Di ujung ruangan sebelah kiri saat masuk ke ruang arsip, bersebelahan dengan arsip koran, saya menemukan lebih banyak lagi tumpukan kardus yang berisi koleksi sastra buku asing. Rupanya, sastra dunia masih tersekap di kardus-kardus rokok di sana.” Tulisan Aufa jadi semacam penunjuk keadaan miris. Cerita yang menyelimuti kegiatan perbukuan memang tak selalu menceritakan kisah yang bahagia. PDS HB Jassin yang dikelola orang-orang “muda” terlihat tidak terlalu diurus dan dipentingkan. Sementara Oyon Sofyan yang sudah sepuh masih bersemangat mengarsip dan menulis buku. Seringnya melihat dan mendengar nama-nama besar yang sudah banyak dikenal dalam dunia perbukuan nampaknya membuat Didiet Dito Sadewo mengisahkan kisah seorang penjual buku. Wondry namanya, seorang pedagang buku Blok M, tempat yang diakrabi banyak pencari buku bekas dan langka. “Berintim-intim dengan Buku” milik Didiet menggambarkan lika-liku pegiat buku “kecil”. Seorang yang sesungguhnya sangat membantu memuaskan dahaga para pencinta buku dan tak banyak dilirik kisahnya. Didiet bahkan berkesempatan mengunjungi rumah si pedagang buku, yang ternyata tak hanya senang menjual buku, tetapi juga bahagia mengoleksinya. Didiet menulis: “Ketika rumah-rumah lain sedang sibuk berusaha mengumpulkan uang untuk membeli perabotan rumah, dan membuat tetangga lain iri untuk membelinya juga, rumah ini tidak. Pemiliknya sibuk mencari buku untuk terus menambah

sesak lagi rumahnya. Di saat pemilik rumah lain mengeluh karena keterbatasan perabotan di rumahnya, juga cemberut saat mendapati rumahnya berantakan. Lain halnya pada rumah Wondry, kesenangannya ialah bukan dengan melihat perabotan rumah yang bagus, tetapi melihat buku-buku bagus, yang sudah menjadi kesenangannya." Dalam buku ini, pembaca disuguhi beragam kisah para pegiat literasi. Mereka punya cara pandang yang berbeda terhadap buku, serta pada tujuan mereka sendiri dalam kegiatan perbukuan yang mereka akrabi dan hayati. Kisah mereka dianggap penting untuk disampaikan, apalagi dalam keadaan keringnya asa perbukuan di Indonesia. Dirasa penting, sebab suatu cerita dapat memberikan suatu impuls, selain daripada pengetahuan yang pastinya juga didapat.
